

Have you completed a Certificate 3 or Statement of Attainment in Outdoor Recreation or have equivalent experience in the Outdoors and wish to upgrade your qualification to a Certificate 4 in Outdoor Recreation?

Well then this course could be for you. This is a part time course, delivered face to face allowing students to work in the Industry during peak periods. It will commence in June 2016 and go through until July 2017. You need to hold a current Wilderness or Remote area first aid certificate (or be willing to obtain in the first term of the course)

Students will undertake in the following activity specialisations as part of the qualification Intermediate Bushwalk – Guide and Flatwater Canoe – Instructor

Students that wish to gain additional skills / qualifications in other activity areas can do so by enrolling in activity specific Statements of Attainment for an additional fee (subject to demand). Successful completion of this course will allow you to operate in an uncontrolled environment and to work independently within a variety of settings and contexts that may be complex and non-routine.

Classroom sessions: Lithgow TAFE

Bushwalking field trips: Kosciusko National Park (Snow shoe walk) and Blue Mountains

Canoeing: It could be either Kangaroo Valley, St Georges Basin, Myall Lakes or Hawkesbury River

Where is Lithgow College?

It is situated 150 km west of Sydney on the edge of the Blue Mountains, however you don't need to live in Lithgow to attend this course.
